to the ATF if you are a winery so they can pull your basic permit. They are AZ, AR, DE, KA, ME, MD, MS, MT, NY, NC, ND, SD, TX, UT, and VA.

The rest of the states are more or less in line for entering the twentyfirst century.

There is light at the end of the tunnel. Consumers in Indiana have filed suit against the state for violating their constitutional rights to free trade between the states. Hopefully, this will go to the Supreme Court and the light at the end of the tunnel won't be a locomotive!


