
Fall 2001

We are heavy into our "Crush" season, with fruit being delivered daily to the winery. Eric and Trey are fast at work crafting the 2001 wines, which are sure to be a delight!

New Releases

We are proud to announce the release of the 1999 wines. If you have already placed your order and have asked us to ship it, we will be sending your wine in early October. Otherwise, your wine will be available at the winery 11am-4pm daily. On October 1st, the following wines were released:

1999 Dunham Cabernet SauvignonV 2000 Shirley Mays White Table Wine 1999 Lewis Vineyard Syrah



Since early spring we have been selling futures on the 1999 wines, and we are bittersweet in reporting that the 1999 Lewis Vineyard Syrah is completely sold out. This Syrah has been an immediate favorite to all of us here at the winery, from the moment we brought in the fruit until the day we bottled the wine. We are sad to see this wine go! The 1999 vintage produced a limited 168 cases of this wonderful Syrah, but never fear, Eric has heard your calls for more of this delightful wine, and has approximately 800 cases in the barrel from the 2000 vintage, which will be bottled next spring.

Year in Review

Just after the last newsletter in May, we held our annual spring open house on May 5 - 6, and the Walla Walla Balloon Stampede weekend was May 12-13. Both weekends were the busiest we have ever seen, with records set throughout the valley for attendance and sales, just going to show you that Walla Walla is just beginning to crack open as one of the hottest wines regions in the world!



In July, Eric and Trey set off to Sun Valley, Idaho for the Sun Valley Center for the Arts Wine Auction. Our auction lot this year included three hand-painted 3 liter bottles of the 1999 Dunham Cabernet Sauvignon V, and three handpainted 3 liter bottles of the much coveted 1999 Lewis Vineyard Syrah. All were hand-painted by Eric. Eric also included dinner and barrel tasting for 6 people as part of the same lot.



On August 25, the Auction of Washington Wines (formerly the Auction of Northwest Wines) was held in Woodinville, Washington at Chateau Ste. Michelle Winery. This is the largest wine auction in the Pacific Northwest, and we were proud to be a part of the event, including a donation of eight 3 liter (double magnums) of wine, roundtrip airfare for 8 to Walla Walla, catered dinner and barrel tasting at the winery, and overnight accommodations at the newly renovated Whitman Towers.


